CURRICULUM

Meerut Public School For Girls is an English Medium School, which prepares pupils for the All India Secondary School Certificate Examination and the Senior School Certificate Examination conducted by the Central Board of Secondary Education-CBSE.

The institution has adopted a rich and varied curriculum which does justice to the diverse needs of our student community, giving proportional importance to co-curriculum, cultural and extra scholastic activities.

Class I to X – The main subjects of study are- English, Hindi, Maths, Science, Social Science, Sanskrit and Foundation of Information Technology.

Class XI to XII – The three streams of study provided are

Science, Commerce and Humanities. The combinations provided are as follows:

Compulsory Subjects

SCIENCE : English, Physics, Chemistry.

COMMERCE : English, Accountancy, Business Studies/Marketing

HUMANITIES: English, Political Science, History

OPTIONAL SUBJECTS : Maths, Home Science, Physical Education, Painting, Geography, Vocal Music, Psychology, Fashion Studies, Economics, Biology, Informatics Practices, Typography, Hindi.

REACHING HEIGHTS

As per the new school education system of 5 + 3 + 3 + 4 outlined in NEP 2020, children will spend five years in the foundational stage, 3 years in the preparatory stage, 3 years in the middle stage and 4 years in the secondary stage.

Every activity in school life plays a significant role in development of students. At MPSFG the Co- Curricular Activities are an integral part that help in enhancing the learning process of students. They are designed and balanced with Academic Curriculum so that every student gets to learn beyond Classroom.

TINY WINGS BIG FLIGHTS- THE FIRST STEP



The kindergarten of the school which is fully air conditioned holds a place of pride, and is based in a specially constructed block aiming to provide a friendly, warm and loving atmosphere to the tiny tots. Hence, coming to school is a joy and delight for them.

A judicious blend of both 'The Montessori' and now the prevalent Play-way 'method is adopted in the kindergarten section. An activity based academic curriculum helps the children to learn as they play.

An assortment of co-curricular activities like Theatre and Drama, Singing and Dancing, Public Speaking, Enaction, Mime, Drawing and Painting are organized for their overall development.

The Kindergarten of the School upholds its motto 'TO GREATER HEIGHTS' so that students within can embark on the journey upwards into adulthood with confidence and elan.



THE PRIMARY SECTION-WHERE BUDS BLOOM

The PRIMARY SECTION of the school has spacious, airy, well-ventilated and well-lit classrooms which form an attractive backdrop for the lessons.

The activity room boasts of a collection of colourful, attractive toys specially chosen to help the little ones develop their foundational skills that prepare them for life, work and active citizenship. A Rest Room and a Sickbay have been provided within the precincts of the Primary Section.



SCHOOL RULES

- Students must come to school in proper School Uniform. Uniform is compulsory at the school functions, Parent Teacher Meetings and on any visit the child may make to the school during working hours. The Students Identity Card will be worn at all times.
- Students must be punctual. Reporting time on all days will be five minutes before the first bell. Entry will not be permitted subsequently.
- During school hours students will not be permitted to leave the premises without prior sanction of the Principal and that too only in case of emergency.
- Students are not allowed to receive visitors during school hours. Lunch/tiffin boxes will not be delivered to the child under any circumstances.
- Students are prohibited from carrying objectionable literature/material to school.
- The use of cell phones is strictly prohibited within the school premises. Confiscation will lead to the imposition of Rs. 500/- fine.
- Overall, 90% Attendance is compulsory. No student will be absent from school without obtaining prior sanction from the Principal. A leave application duly signed by the parent must be submitted to the Class Teacher in advance.
- In case of illness for more than 3 days, a medical certificate by registered Medical Practitioner should be enclosed along with the leave application.
- The student's absence from the school in the beginning of the session for 14 consecutive days would be considered as NSO (Name Struck Off) with no update of status from the Parents' or Guardians side.
- Absence of student for seven days continuously/collectively anytime during the session without any intimation shall again be considered as NSO.
- Students suffering from infectious/contagious diseases shall, under no circumstances, be permitted to attend school until fully recovered.
- The school shall not be held responsible for any unforeseen accident or illness or mishap which may occur during school hours or school trips.
- Parents will be granted entry inside the school only if they carry the Parents' Identity Card with them. Parents' attendance is mandatory at all Parent Teacher Meetings.
- Fee is to be paid by the 15th of every month, failing which a late fee fine will be charged.
- Fees will be paid in bank or through ENTAB. Usage of ENTAB has been made mandatory in our school where parents can go through their wards attendance and can have a track of child's performance.
- The decision of the Principal with regard to Promotion/Detention will be final.
- As the medium of instruction is English, it is highly desirable from students to communicate in English.
