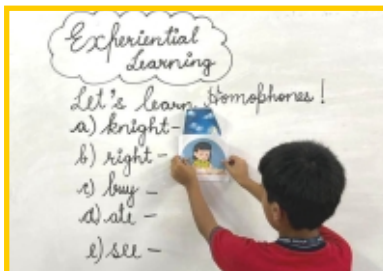


EMBRACING EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING – HOMOPHONE ODYSSEY OF GRADE III

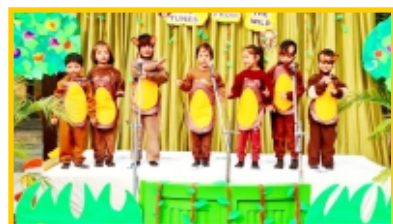
कहानी को जीवन्त बनाते हुए – पपेट शो

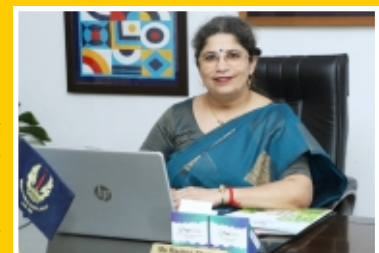

CAREER COUNSELLING WORKSHOP FOR CLASSES X & XII

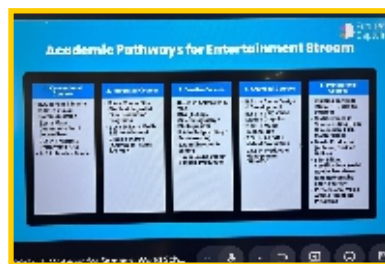
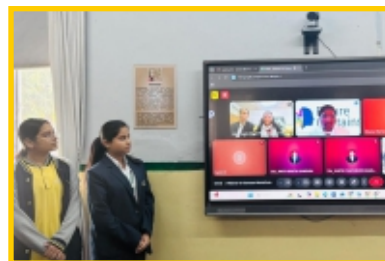

CHRISTMAS - A FESTIVAL OF JOY AND GIVING



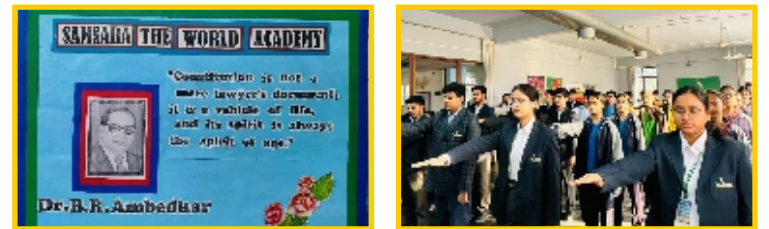

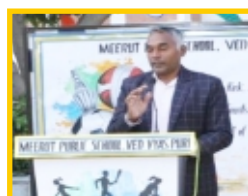
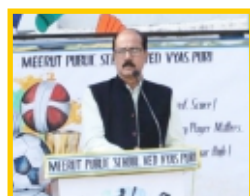

A HERITAGE JOURNEY TO AGRA

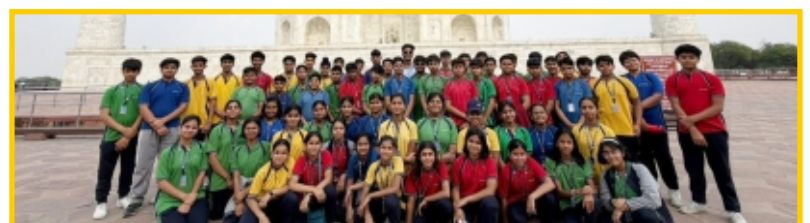

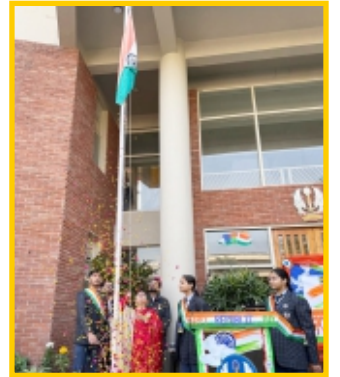
A LEGACY REKINDLED: 6TH FOUNDER'S DAY OBSERVANCE

At MPS, assessment is not about pressure or performance—it is about progress with purpose, where every child feels confident, capable, and motivated to learn.

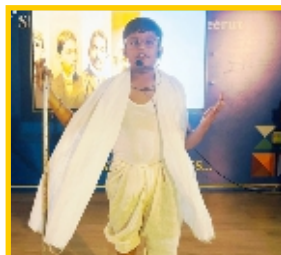
SIMPLICITY, TRUTH AND SERVICE – IDEALS THAT SHAPE A NATION

We bow in reverence to the great Guru, whose words continue to illuminate our path towards truth and compassion



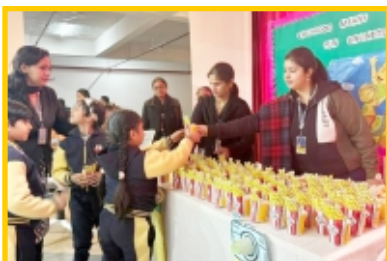
